The successful candidate will be required to work 1:1 with a child supporting their social, emotional and mental health. Experience of working with children who have challenging behaviour and disabilities is desirable.

- Making optimum use of observations to plan effective learning sequences for the child/children
- Working closely with parents
- Effective use of ICT

- Have excellent interpersonal skills
- Be committed to working effectively and restoratively with colleagues; volunteers, parents, children and visitors;

- GCSE Maths & English A-C grades (or equivalent)
